STORIES OF HOW NEW REACH TURNS UNCERTAINTY INTO STABILITY



From Crisis to Comfort

Kayla, her husband Jose and their 8-year-old son came to the U.S. from Venezuela, hoping for a better future. Eight months pregnant and speaking only Spanish, they planned to stay with a friend.

But when the friend relocated for work, everything changed. The landlord let them stay until the end of the month, but without being on the lease, they couldn't remain. With a baby on the way and nowhere to go, Kayla and Jose's family was on the brink of homelessness.

Thankfully, they connected with a Spanish-speaking caseworker from **New Reach's Diversion Team**, who acted quickly. With support, Jose found a job, secured an apartment, and with emergency funding, covered their first month's rent and security deposit. Just in time, they moved into a safe, stable home.

In only five days, a crisis was averted. Thanks to the swift work of our Diversion Team, Kayla's family never had to enter the shelter system. This is the power of diversion — preventing homelessness before it starts.

Marleni's Journey to Stability

In her late 20s, Marleni faced eviction after receiving a notice to quit—a formal warning that her landlord intended to evict her if she didn't leave. With nowhere to turn, she sought help from New Reach's **Prevention** program.

Stewart, her caseworker, immediately stepped in — advocating for her in court and securing a three-month extension. This bought Marleni crucial time to find a new home and regain her footing.



Working quickly, Stewart helped transfer her housing voucher to Bridgeport, where they found an apartment that fit her needs. But Marleni's challenges extended beyond housing — she was also battling addiction, which made it hard to maintain stability and pursue her larger goals.

Recognizing the need for holistic support, New Reach connected Marleni with addiction recovery programs to help her overcome these struggles. With both housing and health addressed, she is not only working toward a stable future but also toward regaining custody of her 3-year-old daughter.

Marleni's story shows the power of comprehensive support — made possible by donors like you. You help New Reach provide more than just housing.
